Motion by DG Dave with stipulation that it be reviewed each year as the money will come from the admin acct, and 2nd by J. Weber. Carried.

- Sight Conservation/Eye Screening – three people interviewed and approved. Lion Sharon reported she has set up an eye screening at a day care on May 26th, and on June 25.
